There were no EMS or BCEDC reports. Mayor Cook reported he issued violations regarding mowing ordinance and property was mowed within the ten days. Mayor Cook shared City Attorney recommendations on updating City housing ordinance to modify Restricted Residence District ordinance to indicate any properties that were not originally built to serve as a residential

single-family structure would require a special permit from the City Council before someone could reside in them as such. Mayor Cook issued nuisance abatement notices to two properties with deadlines of 6/13/24 and 6/28/24. If not abated, the City will abate and assess the costs against the property owner. Councilperson Lamphier attended the 911 meeting where Rick Wulfekuhle may be stepping down as emergency management coordinator due to running for county supervisor and working on updating radios for better communications between counties.

Public Works Director reported water tower inspection went well with no issues. Oasis will be coming to repair washed out lagoon area. Concession stand repairs should be done by 1st of August and the Bush and Albert Street stormwater drain is flowing so going to hold off on replacing pipe.
